Terms & Conditions

In order to be eligible for appointment as Sr. Standing Counsel a person should:-

- (a) Be enrolled / registered as a advocate with the High Court.
- (b) Have a minimum experience of 5 years of handling preferably Custom, Central Excise & Service tax matter before High Court or Tribunals

OR

Have been an officer of the Customs & Central Excise Department who retired / resigned from the post of Commissioner of Customs / Central Excise or above or retired / resigned as Member / Vice President / President of CESTAT / Settlement Commission & is enrolled / registered as an advocate in the High Court. Provided that he has not been removed / dismissed or compulsorily retired from service on account of disciplinary action against him and no disciplinary proceeding under service rules or pension rules is pending against him.

- (a) **Tenure :-** The first appointment of Counsel shall be normally be for a period of three years.
- (b) **Termination of appointment :-** The appointment / empanelment of the Counsel would be terminable on one month's notice in writing by either side without assigning any reason.
- (c) **Right to private practice :-** The Counsel will have the right of private practice, which should not however interfere with the efficient discharge of the work for the department but he should not advised, hold briefs or appear against the department before any authority, Tribunals or Court in matter under statues relating to Indirect Taxation.
- (d) **Fees & Allowances :-** It will be paid as per CBEC's order F.No. 278A/43/2007-Legal dated 05-12-2007.
